

Fredric Watson Elementary School's Parent & Family Engagement Policy

1. Parent Involvement:

This policy has been jointly developed by Fredric Watson Elementary School administration, staff and parents of our students, pursuant to Title 1. Fredric Watson Elementary school will convene an annual meeting which will be held at a convenient time for parents to review. This meeting was held September 5, 2024. Each year administration, staff, and parents will review and revise the school's current Parent & Family Engagement Policy during the spring. An annual meeting will be held in the spring of the year after the different groups have met. The policy will be distributed in an understandable format and, to the extent practicable, in a language parents can understand. The Parent & Family Engagement Policy will also be made available to the community. The annual parent meeting was held on September 5, 2024 at 3:30 and 4:30 to accommodate parents that work and was done online. For parents who are unable to attend we send home a Tuesday folder with the information for them.

1B From the District survey results 86% of the parents feel that communication, technology, family engagement and help for the students the school is provided. The parents from the survey like the school, but would like to see differentiation of the night time activities. We have differentiated the make it take it activities so they do not seem repetitive during the year. Our goal is to increase our participation by 10% on the survey by allowing parents to take the survey during registration times in the spring. Two progress reports are sent home the 25<sup>th</sup> of each month and one is signed and returned. Parents are able to check grades through the Parent Portal Infinite Campus to see student's progress.

2. Parent & Family Engagement Process of School Improvement Review/Implementation:

Administrators and teachers will have access to the Accords whenever needed for parent/student conferences or other occasions.

4. Administration and Staff:

The Fredric Watson Elementary School staff will provide high-quality curriculum and instruction in a supportive and effective learning environment enabling students to meet the state academic standards. The staff will provide assistance to parents, as appropriate, in understanding school wide and CCSD goals. At the beginning of the year the grade levels hosted individual Open Houses to present to the parents the grade levels expectations of academics, curriculum, and behavior. The school sends home weekly Tuesday folders with all pertinent correspondence for the parents. Parents sign and return them to school. Two progress reports are sent home the 25<sup>th</sup> of each month and one is signed and returned. Parents are able to check grades through the Parent Portal Infinite Campus to see student's progress.

4B- Materials and Training:

Efforts are made by the school to coordinate and integrate parent involvement programs and activities. Educational resources and training are provided to help parents work with their child to improve their child's progress through Literacy Night. Surveys and/or evaluations are collected for feedback that are provided in English and Spanish. Translators are made available when needed

4C- With the assistance of parents, training will be provided for teachers, staff, and other school personnel in the value of parents as partners in the academic program, how to effectively communicate with parents, and how to work with parents as equal partners in their child's education. 4D- Administration and staff will ensure information related to the school, parent programs, meetings and other activities are sent to the parents in an understandable format, and in a language that parents can understand. Parents are invited to the Open House for each grade they have a child attend, Parent/Teacher Conferences, Annual Title Meeting, and many night activities that are offered at the school monthly. The parents are informed through the weekly Tuesday folders of any upcoming events or opportunities they may participate in.

4E- Coordination with other programs:

The administration will to the extent feasible and appropriate, coordinate and integrate parent & family engagement programs and activities with Pre-Kindergarten programs, and other available community resources and programs. Watson offers a variety of assistance programs: Breakfast after the Bell, Universal Free Lunch, School Bell, Title 1 Hope, and 3 square food program, Operation School Bell, Counselor Clothing Club, and dental and medical needs referrals.

4F- Families are made aware of these programs by the counselor and correspondence sent home through the Tuesday folders and website. The nurse makes referrals through screenings of vision and hearing. The parents are made aware through the website. Teacher and staff referrals to the counselor. Title 1 Hope information is displayed in the front office. The clerk makes referrals for school bell. The school will provide, to the best of our ability, reasonable support for any assistance, services, or additional parent involvement activities as parents and families may request. Parents are encourage to fill out surveys and evaluations and to communicate with the staff and administration of Fredric Watson Elementary School.

Parent & Family Engagement Activities:
